FAU ITALIAN STUDIES

Il Circolo has been contributing to FAU Italian Studies since its inception in 1986 when Dr. Myriam Ruthenberg started the program, thanks to a \$5,000 grant from Il Circolo. The Program has since flourished due to these donations that funded:

- Many student trips to Italy for summer study abroad in Florence (2000-2008) and Venice (2009-present);
- Concerts and musical events, like "L'Italiano sul Palcoscenico" in 2019; "La Traviata virtual choir" in 2020; and "Concerto per Myriam" in 2021;
- Barbara Salani and Carlos De Antonis's teaching modules of Italian through Music;
- The Pat Valenti Film Series (2012-2017), now called Michele D. Serra New Italian Cinema Series.

This past summer, Il Circolo funded 6 weeks in Italy for 6 students. Three of these students added a week in the Tuscan Castle to study poetry and music with Dr. Serra and Dr. Pettener (a new liaison created by FAU Italian Program, thanks to Barbara Salani's PhD research).

Our graduates are now successful in different fields; to name a few:

- Richard is teaching in a Lombardy high school (thanks to FAU-SITE liaison) for a year;
- Isabella has just been hired at the Italian Consulate General in Miami;
- Zachary is Artist in Residence at the University of Oklahoma;
- Odra was accepted at Ohio State University PhD program;
- Viviana is now teaching at the University of Miami;
- Marianna won the FATI award as best Italian teacher in Florida and is coordinating a large program at West Boca High School.
