
#### HONOREE

**Robert E. Carlucci** is the founder of The RC Group. He has been a leader in the food service industry his entire career, and a multi-state real estate developer and operator of Yum Brands Taco Bell, Kentucky Fried Chicken, and Pizza Hut for more than 30 years.

In Massachusetts he started Robert's Food and Vending Service Company before relocating to Maryland where he joined BCS, a food service company, as CEO. Bob was the founder of Co-Operative Refreshment Centers, and was a co-founder of Bay National Bank where he served as an Executive Board Member and Vice Chairman.

Professional service to organizations includes Taco Bell Ad Hoc Board Member of the Franchise Management Advisory Council (FRANMAC), Vice-Chairman of YUM Brand KFC Government Affairs, President of the Washington D.C. Taco Bell and KFC Co-Op's, President of the KFC North East Franchisee Association, and President of the Maryland-Washington D.C. Vending Association.

Philanthropy plays an important role in both Bob and his wife Aileen's lives as well as in the lives of their adult children, Christina and Dominic. He chaired The United Way Campaign of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, and served on the Board of Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts. He has served as Director, Dinner Chairman, and currently serves as Chairman of the National Italian American Foundation (NIAF). Bob established The Carlucci Entrepreneurship Forum at the American University of Rome where he was a former board member and trustee.



Bob has had the honor of being recognized for his philanthropic work by several organizations. In 2017, he was awarded The Ellis Island Medal of Honor. He was awarded an Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters Honoris Causa by The American University of Rome, and he was knighted by The Sacred Military Order of St. George. The prestigious Lido Civic Club of Washington, D.C. named Bob Businessman of the Year, and he received The Mattie J.T. Stepanek Heart Songs Award from The Muscular Dystrophy Association of Washington D.C./ Maryland.

In 2023, Bob was named a Cavaliere (Knight) in Italy's Order of Merit by the Italian government for his many years of dedicated service to the Italian American community and his leadership of the National Italian American Foundation (NIAF).



#### HONOREE

John Flora was born into a poor family of tailors in Bari, Italy. Impoverished and speaking no English, his family emigrated to America on December 17, 1962 and he grew up in the predominately Italian neighborhood of Bensonhurst in Brooklyn, NY.

While initially pursuing an education in Electrical Engineering, he looked for part-time work to earn money and began working in Villa Cucci Bakery, not realizing that this was the start of his food career.

It was while vacationing in Miami Beach that John realized he loved the Sunshine State, but he could not find authentic pizza anywhere. This led him to purchase a piece of property at Flagler and 79th Street in Miami and, shortly thereafter, Flora's Drive-In pizza parlor opened in 1972.

The success of the pizza parlor fueled an expansion to Flora's Italian Restaurant in Hollywood, FL. Tourists and locals alike began to know the restaurant as the place for authentic Italian food, with ingredients sourced directly from Italy. Soon, the competition took note and when other restaurants began asking about acquiring the same Italian ingredients, John began Flora Foods, his restaurant supply business.

Today, after 40 years in business, Flora Fine Foods remains a family business with headquarters in Coral Springs, FL, in a 60,000 square foot distribution facility servicing supermarkets, Italian grocers and specialty food stores across the country. John and Mrs. Flora still work there every day, and John still visits Italy to source genuine Italian ingredients for authentic Italian cooking. To this day only the best can bear the Flora name.
